4/4 Marches: Scotland the Brave, the Wearing of the Green
2. Sword Dance: **Becky Craig & George Balderose** on The Great Highland Pipes:
The Ghillie Chalum for three slow steps and one quick step
3. Slip Jig: **Clíodhna Graven & George Balderose** on The Great Highland Pipes:
The Rocky Road to Dublin played for four steps of the Irish Slip
4. Explanation of where the pipe music and dances come from, and how the pipes work, using overhead transparencies.
5. Pipe Medley of Songs: **George Balderose** on The Great Highland Pipes:
Kumbalya, Michael Row the Boat Ashore, etc.
6. Seann Triubhas: **Becky & George** on The Great Highland Pipes:
Whistle o'er the Love O' it for four slow steps and one quick step
7. Irish Reel: **Clíodhna & George** on The Great Highland Pipes:
The High Road to Linton, Sleepy Maggie, played for four steps.
8. Pipe Medley of Songs: **George Balderose** on The Great Highland Pipes:
This Old Man, Mary Had a Little Lamb, B-I-N-G-O
9. Highland Fling: **Becky & George**
Orange and Blue sung with mouth music by George for the first two steps, and played on smallpipes for the last two sets
10. Irish Slow Hornpipe: **Clíodhna & George**
Madame Bonaparte played for four steps on smallpipes
11. Smallpipe Solo Tunes: **George**
Mount Your Baggage, John Anderson My Jo, The Souters of Selkirk, Go to Berwick, Johnny, Wee Todum Fogg
12. Irish Jig + Scottish version: **George, Clíodhna & Becky**
Deborah and Mary alternating 2 steps each with the Irish Jig (Mary) and the Scottish version of the Irish Jig (Deborah), and dancing the last two steps together. Tunes played on Great Pipes for 10 steps of jig music are: *The Irish Washerwoman, Paddy's Leather Britches, The Kesh Jig*
